



A Celebration of Life has been scheduled at the San Marcos Conference Center afterwards between 6-8 PM. Joe Titus





924TH'S FINAL FLIGHT AT BERGSTROM

■ Four F-16C fighter pilots say goodbyes after last mission

The four F-16C fighter pilots were there to say goodbye on the tarmac at Bergstrom, where they were first spotted by visitors, pilots and family members watching from the tarmac as the wing while standing on the Bergstrom Air Reserve Station flight line.

They were awaiting the end of the final mission for the 924th Fighter Wing and the 704th Fighter Squadron. "Out jaws," the four fighters finally came in from the wild blue yonder made several low-level passes down the runway and over the base then taxied back to a halt, with the heat and wail of the engines. Although the 924th was officially

officially over all operations until Sept. 30.

Thursday's flight ended at 3 p.m. "It's been terrible," said Lt. Col. Henry Graves, 924th Operations Group commander, who was lead pilot for the unit's final mission, air combat training in the Roosevelt Military Operations Area. "It's one of those things you know will come though you hate to see it happen. It's been a good career and a

great unit. You have to see it end this way."

After 14 years of duty beginning in 1983 at Ellington Air Force Base near Houston, the 924th was folded for deactivation said in this year by the Defense Base Closure and Realignment Commission. Many of the personnel have already begun transitioning to other assignments or retirement, and the four F-16Cs in the final mission were the last aircraft left in the unit.

They will join the 924th's 11 other fighters that already have been flown to MacDill Air Force Base in Florida to be taken over by the 4th Fighter Wing, also a reserve unit. Joining Graves on the unit's final sortie were Lt. Col. Edward Pyron, 704th Fighter Squadron commander; Lt. Col. Stephan Higgs, 704th Fighter Squadron operations officer; and Lt. Col. Thomas
