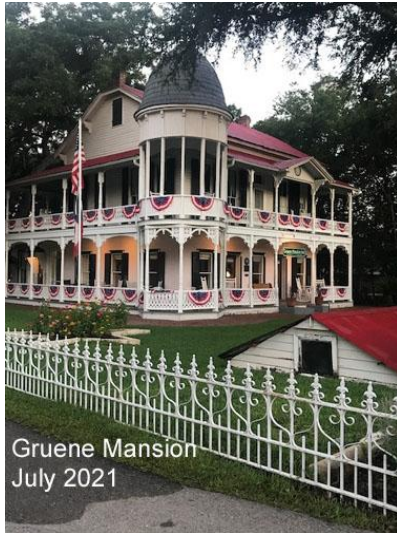

Then someone steps up with lantern and blade

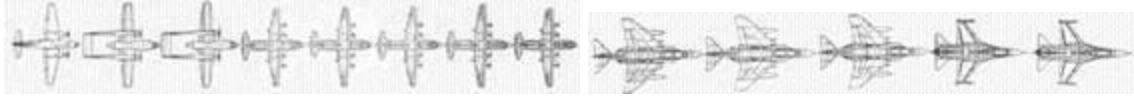
Shouting, “Let’s gather them in for us all, good neighbor!

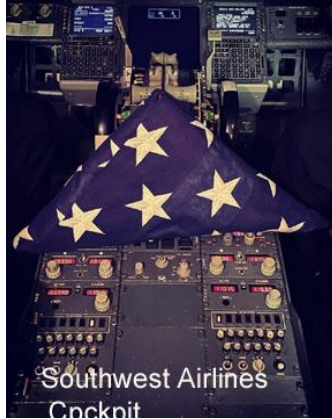


Butch Einkleman's Son, Captain for Southwest Airlines, Honoring military person:

When Jon, a Southwest Gate Agent, noticed a Customer carrying a folded flag as she boarded a flight to COS, he asked her about it. Here's what happened next, as told by Chloe, the Customer:

"I was on my way home from my brother Jay's funeral with Nick. I received a folded flag with the rest of my family while we were there. I couldn't fit it into my carry on so I decided to hand carry it home. When we were standing at our gate in Denver, a gate agent asked me why I was holding such an important thing and I explained to him why. He immediately gave me a hug and said "Thank you so much for his service. You'll be getting pre-boarded tonight." Age 21 to 23 full time student/Age 23 with TRICARE young adult)

31 Oct 21 - Dependents of AD/Guard/Reserve/National Guard members & dependents

31 Jan 22 - Retirees and their dependents; all other populations
