

We’ll bring forth those hidden in the shade, and


Share them with one and another!



Steve was a Weapons Systems Officer (WSO), joined 704 TFS Apr 1981, moved to HQ 10AF in 1986, then to Hill AFB UT, then back to HQ 10AF. He retired in Weatherford, Texas. About 5 years ago he developed a rare blood disorder and battled it mightily, enrolling in numerous research trials at MD Anderson. Mid-2020 the illness developed into acute leukemia. Once again, he was admitted to MD Anderson for an aggressive, month-long treatment, which was said to have put the cancer into remission. Days after returning home, he was admitted to local hospital, diagnosed with sepsis, fought with all his might, but lost the final battle.

I wanted to let everyone know about his passing. He had super great memories of his friends and co-workers in the Reserves.



Chief Willy Update: 1 March 2021





924th F-4E at AMARG boneyard....QF-4E FSAT 72-1490

On June 27th, 1991 she arrived at AMARG from the US AFRES 924thTFG / 704th TFS, based at Bergstrom AFB, TX (FP710) The 924th flew the F-4 from 1981 till 1991, and was the last AFRES unit to fly the F-4E. In 2003 she left AMARG and got converted to FSAT at BAe Systems at Mojave, CA (AF252) After a short period with the 53rd WEG she returned to AMARG in September 2008 (FP1112). She left AMARG again to rejoin the 82nd ATRS / Det 1 in February 2009. She was assigned to the USAF Heritage Flight. In general all FSAT aircraft receive orange wingtips and a vertical stabilizer, but as the USAF Heritage Flight F-4s were used to represent the USAFs history during the Vietnam War, these Phantoms received a more typical Phantom camouflage colorscheme. **Eventually, she was destroyed over the WSMR on July 18th, 2014** Photographed at Holloman AFB, NM in 2011
